### Information Sheet for High School Transportation

- Bussing is available to all three high schools from within the City of Brandon and rural areas.
- High School students must reside further than 2.4 km from the school they are attending to meet eligibility requirements for transportation on a Brandon School Division school bus.
- Students are transported to school from a pickup point closest to their residence and are returned to a drop off point closest to their residence.
- Students attending two different schools may meet the eligibility requirement to or from one school but not the other. For example, a student that attends Vincent Massey in the morning and resides less than 2.4 km from the school would not be eligible for transportation to Vincent Massey in the morning, however if the student attends Crocus Plains or Neelin in the afternoon and lives further than 2.4 km from that school, then the student would be eligible for bussing to the serviced bus stop closest to their residence.

#### Noon hour Shuttle Schedule(s):

**Tri-Hi Shuttle I** – runs daily from the first day of classes in September to the last day of final exams in June.

**Tri-Hi Shuttle II** – runs daily from the beginning of Semester 2 to the last day of final exams in June. This shuttle schedule is subject to change due to demand. See BSD Website, Transportation, for up-to-date information.

N	1:05	Pickup & Drop Off
CP	1:10	Drop Off

- **Early Shuttle:** Students are returned to their morning school, from Crocus Plains only for the purpose of attending curricular activities at that school at the end of the day via route R3 (Red 3) departing Crocus Plains at 2:55 p.m. These students require written permission from their teacher to be allowed to take this bus as they will have to leave their last class early in order to meet the scheduled departure time. **All this bussing is in place within the regularly scheduled transportation needs in order to meet dismissal times of the entire division.**
- The Transportation Department will obtain the names of those students eligible for transportation from the sending school(s) once the students have received their placement for Grade 9. The Transportation Department then assigns the appropriate bussing and shall notify students of their transportation arrangements.
- Please notify both the School and the Transportation Department immediately of any residence changes.
