Dear École Harrison Families,

I am sure that you are aware that on Friday, Chief Provincial Public Health Officer Dr. Roussin moved the Prairie Mountain Health region to the Restricted Orange Level again which requires 2 metres of physical distancing in K-8 schools.

The ongoing goal of the school is to continue to provide the best educational experience for your child which is in-class learning, and so we will be restructuring within our school to comply with the new health measure. To accomplish this, we will be utilizing our shared spaces (industrial arts room, music room and gymnasium).

We will take the rest of this week to set up new spaces and with full implementation effective on Monday, November 9. Until then, students will be attending their regular classes under our existing yellow protocols currently in place.

We will also continue to provide programming support to our students who are self-isolating or who are sick, as we have been doing since the beginning of September. As always, the safety and well-being of our students and staff is our utmost concern, along with providing appropriate learning opportunities with our students. We are committed to flexibly adapting our learning environment to meet both these goals.
