Notification of Routing Information for the upcoming School Year-

In our efforts to “Go Green”, the Transportation Department will only be sending letters to some students with their bussing information for the next school year.

- 1) If your student(s) are residing at the same address and will be attending the same school as in the previous school year, school bus transportation arrangements will remain the same and no letter will be sent.
- 2) If there are any changes to transportation arrangements for students in item 1) due to new routing, you will be notified by letter from the Transportation Department.
- 3) If your student resides at a rural address or is receiving curbside service, the bus route driver will contact you the day before school commences. This practice is unchanged from previous years.
- 4) Students advancing to Grade 9 who are eligible for school bus transportation will receive a letter (or telephone call, see item 2) from the Transportation Department.
- 5) Students entering school for the first time, Kindergarten, and who are eligible for school bus transportation will receive a letter (or telephone call, see item 2) from the Transportation Department.
- 6) The Transportation Department does operate throughout the months of July and August. Please notify us, as soon as possible, of any changes in residence. Our telephone number is 729-3975.
