Kirkcaldy Parent Council would like to keep you informed on where your fundraising dollars are going. We create a budget at the beginning of each year and have some standard items that we contribute to annually. We ensure that all students at the school will benefit from the contributions and fundraising. Some of those are The Volunteer/Citizenship award for two graduating students at the end of the year, special events, Library Memorial fund, Teacher Appreciation, \$200 a year rotates between the library, resource gym and Music departments. Music received it last year and it will be going to the gym this year. Also items such as a contribution to a year end field trip for each class. We have raised it from \$50 per class to cover a bus this year, and help contribute to costs to send students to the Science fair. We will have the official budget posted on the PAC bulletin board so you can take a look.
