Trustee Murray spoke on a concern regarding the school playgrounds. Currently, Brandon School Division, school parent councils and the City of Brandon contribute funds for new school play structures.

For approximately 10 years, there has been an agreement with the City of Brandon and Parent Councils to share costs for the school play structures. This agreement provides equity between schools that are better able to do the fundraising, and schools that struggle to raise those funds. He indicated that we need to put this out in the community so that people have fair warning that the deal in place with our school parent councils for these play structures is not going to be there any longer. The announcement by Cliff Cullen is going to put a burden on parent councils. There was also a schedule put in place to replace older play structures, which assists school parent councils in knowing the timeline and how much they need to fundraise. The majority of the structures at Division schools are over \$100,000, which becomes an impossible feat for parent councils for fundraising.

Trustee Murray asked if the Board would be in favour of sending out a letter to parent councils in the Division to let them know, and given them fair warning, that this deal no longer exists. He believes people need to know this and start talking to the MLAs about where this money is going to come from, now that the Province has done away with Divisions.

Trustee Bambridge spoke in favour of holding a virtual meeting with parent council representatives and welcoming any questions they may have concerning the situation.

Trustee Gobeil thanked his fellow Trustees for bringing up this matter and spoke in support of the virtual meeting. The more the Division creates the environment of learning and understanding what is actually happening with the changes of Government, it is going to better inform all of us citizens and parents who have children in the system. This is really going to change how we look and how we form ourselves, not just as a Division but as parent councils moving forward.

Trustee Bambridge suggested that the MLAs also be invited to attend the meeting with parent councils.

The Board supported holding a virtual meeting with parent councils and MLAs.
