

ATTENTION VOLUNTEERS

Volunteers, Parents and Community Members

It is Brandon School Division policy that volunteers complete a Criminal Record Check and a Child Abuse Registry Check. If you are planning on volunteering in ANY capacity ON A REGULAR BASIS for the Brandon School Division these checks MUST be completed. This process can take several weeks, so please visit your school office as soon as possible to complete the necessary forms. You will need to bring two (2) pieces of government issued identification, one piece MUST be a phot identification. There is NO charge for these checks if processed through your school office.

Once your Criminal Record Check has been returned to the Brandon School Division and your Child Abuse Registry Check is on file, your name will be added to the approved volunteer list and your school will be notified.

As long as you continue to volunteer in the Brandon School Division schools each year you will not be required to repeat these checks. We appreciate your support and help to our staff and students, and thank you sincerely!
