YMCA Before & After School Program 2018 - 2019

The YMCA is pleased to be offering the Before & After School Program for the 2018-2019 school year. All children that are new to the Before and After School Program will be able to pick up registration forms at the YMCA, on **March 12**th **2018**. This is allowing for you to fill out the paper work to have ready.

We will post how many spots there are available at each school on our website www.ymcabrandon.ca by March 27, 2018. If there are no spaces please still register because we do have a wait list and still may get in. Registrations will be accepted on April 2, 2018 at the Member Services desk of the YMCA for any remaining spots. Waitlists will be started that day as well. Doors open at 5:30 am. First come first serve. If your registration form is missing any information, it will be mailed back to you and your spot will not be held. Please ensure your registration form is accompanied with a Pre-Authorized Payment Agreement form that must include a void cheque, Visa or Master Card information, or account verification form stamped by your bank.

The monthly fees for the program will be \$80.00 for AM Care only, \$125.00 for PM Care only and \$205.00 for AM + PM care. Payments are processed on the 20th of the prior month (August 20th – May 20th). The YMCA in partnership with the United Way has subsidized this program and has tried to keep the fees affordable. If your family is unable to pay the full fee please contact the Before and After School Director to discuss our financial assistance program.



Riding the Bus

Kindly review the following good school bus passenger rules with your child:

- * Take your seat right away and remain seated until leaving the bus.
- * Each driver will assign seating and a seating plan in effect.
- * Eating or drinking is not permitted on the school bus.
- * Aisles are to be kept clear at all times. Books and parcels should be kept on your lap.
- * Students shall refrain from loud or boisterous talking or yelling.
- * Do not use abusive or obscene language.
- Never throw objects inside the school bus or out the windows.
- * Windows should only be opened with the permission of the driver. Keep your hands, feet, arms and head inside the school bus at all times.
- * Students shall not touch the emergency door or exits or any part of the bus equipment, unless directed to do so.
- * Students will be responsible for any willful damage or vandalism to the school bus.
- * Promptly obey the driver's instructions.
- * Objects of a dangerous or objectionable nature will not be allowed on the bus.
- * Always treat your driver and other passengers with respect and courtesy.
- * The driver will report disciplinary problems to the principal who will determine the disciplinary measures to be taken.
- * The principal shall be guided by a three step procedure for discipline handling: discussion, warning and finally suspension.
- * All Divisional rules, policies and procedure that are applicable to students in school are also applicable while riding the bus.

As the Science Fair approaches please note the following:

* Parents are expected to provide transportation for their children when bulky or large items such as projects and sports equipment (i.e. skis) must be take to and from school.
