Winter Weather Information

Now that the weather is turning chilly, we would like to remind our parents and students of a few safety tips during the upcoming winter months.

- Dress appropriately for the weather - extra layers for your legs, feet and hands;
- Always wear toques and gloves when playing outside;
- Remove wet clothing immediately and change in to dry clothes as soon as possible;
- Teach children not to play around snowplow areas;
- Teach children never to touch or lick exposed metal (fences, flagpoles, etc.) in winter;
- Do not allow children to dig snow tunnels or forts as they may collapse.
