## King George School Supply Lists 2022 - 2023

**ALL students need to have a backpack and a pair of indoor, non-marking shoes.  
Please label ALL supplies, including shoes, jackets, backpacks, etc.  
ALL students need to provide 2 boxes of tissue to their teacher**

### **Kindergarten Supplies:**

Change of clothing needs to be put in a large Ziploc bag and labelled with your child's name, backpack, indoor shoes, \$50.00 school supply fee and the teacher will purchase all the supplies

**Grades 1 - 6** - \$50.00 school supply fee on first day of school and the teacher will purchase all the supplies.

**Grades 7 - 8** - \$65.00 supply fee on first day of school and the teacher will purchase all the supplies

### **Art Supply Fee:**

\$15.00 dependent upon each teacher for specific, special projects

### **Gym Supplies for Grades 3 - 8:**

Running shoes (non-marking sole), shorts, t-shirt, deodorant

### **Grade 7 & 8 Band**

Black pants, black socks, black shoes, plain black dress shirt, 1 pkg. non mechanical pencils/duotang with loose-leaf and a pencil  
BSIMA rental fee - \$125.00 (if you need to rent an instrument for the year)
