To help ensure that Brandon School Division students have the best possible education, teachers frequently seek to use Third-Party Educational Applications with their students. These apps frequently require students to have accounts, allowing the teacher to differentiate among their students. Creating a student account often involves the disclosure of some of the student's basic personal information.

Some of these apps are also designated as Social Media Applications. Social Media Apps provide avenues for communication, either in a "private" channel (students, parents, and teachers communicating with each other) or in a "public" channel (communication external to BSD).

By checking the box below, I as parent or legal guardian (or student of the age of majority):

- consent to my child accessing Third-Party Educational Applications as outlined in the Social Media and Third-Party Educational Applications Administrative Procedure.
- understand that my child's basic personal information may be collected and processed by these apps in countries including, but not limited to, Canada and the United States.
- understand that I will be notified of the use of specific apps prior to student accounts being created.
- understand that I may withdraw my permission granted herein, with written notice, at any time.

These additional rules apply to all Social Media accounts:

- I will only use the site for the purpose of communicating as outlined by the teacher.
- 2. I will always be respectful in my communications with others and will not use any profane language or say anything which may offend anyone else.
- 3. I understand that my communication on the site is governed by the following Brandon School Division Administrative Procedures: Code of Conduct and Respectful Workplace. If I breach any of these rules I may be disciplined and/or lose my ability to access the site as well as lose computer privileges at my school.
- 4. I understand that anything I post on the site, or any communication I have with other users on the site, whether on a public wall or as a personal message, is not a private communication and may be viewed by my teacher, the School Leader, other students and users of the site.
- 5. I understand that anything I post on the site may stay available on the internet forever and cannot be deleted.
- 6. I also understand that I am not required to have an account and to access the site in order to pass my coursework at the school.
- 7. I have discussed and reviewed this document and the Social Media and Third-Party Educational Applications Administrative Procedure with my parents, where I am under the age of 18.
