The Brandon School Division believes there is a strong positive correlation between student achievement and effective student/teacher relationships in the Kindergarten classroom.

When the Kindergarten population of a school reaches 27 or more students, a second half-day class shall be formed where there is available classroom space.

When the Kindergarten population of a school reaches 53 or more students, a third half-day class shall be formed where there is available classroom space.

Class composition is important in determining an appropriate class size for any Kindergarten class. The School Leader and Superintendent/CEO or designate will monitor Kindergarten classes determining when it is necessary to establish a second half-day class for schools having Kindergarten enrollment under 27 students.
