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The United Referral and Intake System (URIS) is a joint initiative of the Departments of Families, Health, Seniors and Active Living, and Education and Training. The protocol supports students attending school who have special health care needs and require assistance when they are apart from their parents/guardians. URIS has adopted categories that identify differing levels of complexity in health care procedures and identifies the professional qualification required by personnel to support these students.

Brandon School Division adopts the United Referral and Intake System (URIS) Policy and Procedural Manual as the standard by which we shall meet the special health care needs of students in our schools.

The Division in partnership with Prairie Mountain Health annually reviews and develops a United Referral Intake System (URIS) Operational Plan to identify and support students requiring URIS B support.
