The Brandon School Division provides for continuity of school operations in the absence of the School Leader (Principal/Vice Principal) by designating a Head Teacher. The Head Teacher assumes the responsibility for the operation of the school on a daily basis in the approved absence of the School Leader. The Head Teacher is responsible for:

- safety and security of the school;
- student conduct;
- emergency procedures; and
- communication.

The Head Teacher continues with their teaching duties when the School Leader is absent. In the event of circumstances requiring immediate attention, the Head Teacher is to cover for their class through internal school arrangements. If that is not possible, the Head Teacher is to request direction from the Assistant Superintendent.

- A Head Teacher shall be designated and appointed for each of the schools in the Division. The designation of Head Teacher shall be approved by the Division prior to June 30th of each year with the appointment becoming effective the first day of school in the fall term.
- Payment of Head Teacher allowances shall be made in accordance with the *BTA Collective Agreement*.
- School Leaders are required to obtain prior approval for their absence when it is anticipated and the said absence shall be greater than 90 minutes; and when the School Leader is absent for a period greater than 90 minutes without prior approval, the School Leader is required to provide an explanation in writing for the said absence to the Superintendent/CEO or designate.

- School Leaders will meet prior to the school year with the Head Teacher to provide orientations on regulations and administrative procedures to facilitate the safe and efficient operation of the school.
- Where a school has both a Principal and a Vice-Principal, the school shall be eligible for a Head Teacher only in the event of the absence of both School Leaders.
