Transportation service for Grades K-12 students living within the City of Brandon shall be provided inner-city transportation services from designated pick-up posts under the following conditions:

1. Grades K-8 students living within the City of Brandon and having more than 1.6 kilometres to walk in order to reach the designated school attended shall be provided with school bus transportation services;
2. Grades 9-12 students living within the City and having more than 2.4 kilometres to walk to reach the assigned school attended shall be provided with school bus transportation service.

Transportation service for Grades K-12 students living within the City shall be provided in accordance with points 1 and 2 above and to those students who by regulation shall be provided with transportation service, and to the following areas on an exception basis:

1. West of 18th Street and North of Grand Valley Road due to students having to cross Highway #10 in a 70 km/hr zone with no pedestrian provisions – Grades 7 and 8 within 1.6 kms of Kirkcaldy Heights School;
2. South of the Assiniboine River and North of the C.P. Rail tracks and between 18th and 34th Streets
 - Grades 7 and 8 French Immersion within 1.6 kms of École New Era School.
3. South of the Assiniboine River and North of the C.P. Rail tracks and between 1st and 18th Streets
 - Grades K-8 within 1.6 kms of New Era School
4. South of the Assiniboine River and North of the C.P. Rail tracks and between 18th and 34th Street – Grades K-6 within 1.6 kms of Earl Oxford School

And that; for the purpose of this procedure, the following definitions shall apply:

- “designated” shall mean the nearest school at which the program of choice by the student is offered; and
- “program” shall mean a series or group of courses leading to a statement of standing
