All Brandon School Division buses shall stop at all controlled or uncontrolled railway crossings located outside the boundaries of any city, town or village in the manner described in [The Highway Traffic Act](#). In addition, the hazard warning lights are to be activated prior to stopping at and deactivated upon proceeding across the railway crossing.

All Division school buses shall stop at all controlled or uncontrolled railway crossings located within the boundaries of any city, town or village, while transporting students, in the following manner:

The driver shall prepare to stop at the railway crossing in the manner described in [The Highway Traffic Act](#), but will pull to the right only when traveling in the left-hand lane and the right-hand lane is either a traveled lane or a parking lane. If no parking lane is present, the driver will remain in the right-hand most traveled lane. In a situation where the right-hand lane is a turning lane, the driver will remain in the traveled lane.
